

KinoKultura Reviews: Some Guidelines

Reviews should be at least 1,000 words long. There is NO set length for a review as it always depends on the film, and the reviewer, how much can be said.

Please indicate the director, film title in English, original title and year of release, as well as your name and affiliation at the top of the review.

Please give the full credits for the film in the usual format at the end of the review.

Please use a minimum of endnotes: this is a film review, not an academic article.

Please use the Harvard system [AUTHOR YEAR OF PUBLICATION AND PAGE IN BRACKET] for references and provide a list of works cited at the end (again, keep this to a minimum).

Please use American spelling and punctuation, and use the m-dash [—] without spaces (rather than n-dash [-]).

If you wish to select your own images, please do NOT paste them into the text but send them as jpg files separately, with film title and number (filmtitle1, filmtitle2, etc.), and indicate where these images should be placed in the text. Images should be 300 pixels wide.
